- Support our local environment, using local suppliers where practical to do so

Examples of our policy in practice

Recycling

The Willowfield recycles paper, cardboard, plastics, fabrics, Cooking Oil, toner cartridges and tin foil. This includes waste that our guests leave behind.

How can you help?

Please help us by segregating your recyclable waste from the rest to reduce the impact on the landfill sites.

Energy Saving

The Willowfield has more than 150 light bulbs. 50% of these bulbs are low energy bulbs. We aim to replace a further 25% with low energy bulbs within the coming year.

Use of PIR switches for certain lighting. These were fitted to avoid lights being left on unnecessarily and also to ensure safe lighting when needed.

Radiators are turned off when rooms are not in use. We are currently in the process of having a number of radiators fitted with new valves to help control the temperature.

Televisions and other such equipment is turned off at the mains and is not left on standby.

Towels are only changed and laundered when guests request us to do so.

We only launder full loads

How can you help?

Please turn lights off when not in use. Switch the television off at the wall overnight and whilst out for the day.

Please turn down your radiator while you are out. Don't leave the window open while the radiator is turned up.

Reduction in water use

All 14 toilets in The Willowfield have been fitted with 'Hippo Bags' to reduce the quantity of water that is required to refill the cistern.

How can you help?

Please don't leave the taps running when not in use - e.g.; while brushing your teeth.
